1. Waterton Artisan Fair is part of the **Waterton Wildflower Festival on June 14-19, 2018.**
2. Booths are available for:
  - a. 1 day: \$36.75
  - b. 2 days: \$63.00
  - c. 3 days: \$78.75
3. Price includes: GST, 6x6 foot floor space, 2 chairs, Wi-Fi, free park entrance. Please advise if you need more space and we try to accommodate.
4. Please bring your own table!
5. Booths have to be attended by a vendor/exhibitor at all times to give visitors a valuable experience.
6. Free booths will be located in the hallway and are available for organizations with educational purposes.
7. Application deadline is **April 1, 2018**. We reserve the right to select vendors, which fit most the purpose of the Festival. No exhibitor will have exclusive rights to products. Other exhibitors will be allowed to sell a similar product however we will do our best to ensure there is not an abundance of similar items.
8. Payment is due 10 days after receiving confirmation by e-mail.
9. Please be aware that the Waterton Artisan Fair is a bit different than other fairs as it is part of a nature festival. The purpose is to promote arts and crafts that represent and cherish nature and aboriginal culture. Our goal is to enhance the experience for the festival's participants and to offer an arts and crafts sale to the public of the surrounding communities as well as tourists visiting Waterton Lakes National Park. The Waterton Artisan Fair with 15 to 20 exhibitors is a small but fine and lovely fair. The spotlight is set at each and every vendor. We keep the cost per booth fairly low, as the fair is still a hidden treasure and in an early stage of establishment with 2018 being the third edition.

## Waterton Wildflower Festival

The Waterton Wildflower Festival is an annual event celebrating 2018 it's 15th anniversary. Wildflower and nature enthusiast from all over Alberta, Canada the US and even Europe come to Waterton to participate in this well-established event. It offers 6 days full of guided hikes and walks, indoor presentations, movies and workshops related to wildflowers and nature in the midst of the spectacular setting of Waterton Lakes National Park. The Waterton Community Center (Old School) is the main hub for the Festival hosting the registration and information desk, food vendors (on some days), the Artisan Fair and some of the workshops.
